Near the famous Venice Beach Boardwalk





Near the bustling and weird Venice Beach Boardwalk (to the rear of the Venice Ale House, to be exact), and just steps from the sand, you'll find a shingled cottage with a turret for sale for \$10.25 million.


It's more cottage in feel than size. The property measures 6,000 square feet, quite generous for a Southern California beach house, and holds a three-bedroom "bungalow" built in 1924, along with a three-level guest house.


