Highlights include hardwood floors, skylights and sliding glass doors that brighten the living spaces. The living room, which features built-ins and a fireplace, opens up to a balcony. Updates to the kitchen include stainless steel appliances and a breakfast bar.

The master suite has a brick fireplace and an updated bathroom for a total of two bedrooms and three bathrooms.

Tamblyn bought the town home more than a decade ago for \$1.175 million, according to public records.
