Where: 910 Dickson Street, Venice

Asking: \$4,250,000

Who: The sellers are fashion entrepreneurs **Kelly Furano** (True Religion, The Row, Elizabeth + James) and her husband Keith Eshelman (TOMS Shoes, **Parks Project**).

What: A 4-bed, 3-bath 2014 renovation by designer/developer Kim Gordon, who started her career creating shell-framed mirrors and evolved into one of Venice's most sought-after creators of

effortlessly chic homes, both renovations and new, bespoke projects.



Hallmarks: High ceilings (here, over 10-foot high) white walls and custom, industrial-style steel windows, plus an adroit use of warm wood details, often from recycled timber. Gordon's easy-going vibe conveys a kind of beachy serenity without the kitsch. You know you're in Venice.



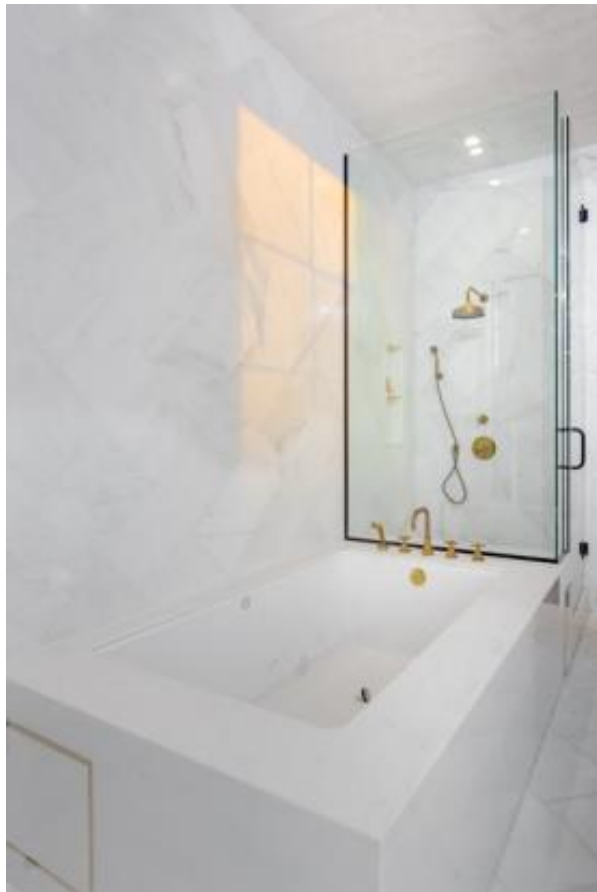
What We Love: The open, elevated kitchen is equipped with two dishwashers, lots of prep space and a discreet pantry that segues into a home office. Countertops are **Richlite**, an almost indestructible composite material made of resin and recycled paper (originally used in laboratories) that's become a favorite of designers for both interior and exterior applications.
