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# **TRENDS** Swimming in the Lap Pool of Luxury: 8 Lap Pools Ready for a Buyer to Dive In

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Lap pools offer nearly all the fun-filled (and fitness) benefits of a larger pool, but take up less space at a fraction of the cost.

In fact, some homeowners are actually drowning in regret over the full-sized pools in their backyards. A common refrain was voiced by home owner **James Sinclair** of Sherman Oaks. "It's just my wife and me here now, and we only swim in our pool about two or three times a year," he says. "The

neighborhood dogs use it more than we do! It dominates the entire backyard, and maintenance costs an arm and a leg. We use our jacuzzi a lot more."

**Tami Halton Pardee**, CEO and founder of Halton Pardee + Partners, specializes in properties on the coastal side of Los Angeles, and says that lap pools are becoming increasingly popular, especially since lots on the West side are generally smaller.

"There's duality in what they do for people," she says. "It's a water feature for some, it's a physical form of exercise for others."

"Normal pools are great," she says. "But sometimes they overtake the yard. Most people want both a yard *and* a pool." She's recently sold homes where the buyer has wound up reducing the size of the backyard pool. "I think that's beginning to be a trend," she says, noting that with resistance jets, those who use their pools for exercise can get just as much of a workout in a lap pool. As far as adding to the property value is concerned, Halton Pardee thinks a lap pool and a regular-sized pool are about equal. "Both add about 3%-5%, depending on the pool," she says.

# 2919 Sanborn Ave, Venice, CA

#### Price: \$6,495,000

**Splashy features:** Designer **Jae Omar** created this indoor/outdoor lap pool, surrounded by a wood deck that reflects the top-to-bottom paneling running throughout the first level of this four-bedroom home. Although the beach is within walking distance, the private lap pool is a lot more convenient, and keeps prying eyes (and photographers) at bay.

# 11616 Charnock Rd, Los Angeles, CA

## Price: \$3,187,000

**Splashy features:** This slender pool runs the length of the home and ends in a waterfall-wall that doubles as an outdoor movie screen, creating a float-in movie theater. Or you can relax with your feet in the water from the lap pool's Baja shelf. The 3,111-square-foot home is brand-new, and features bedrooms with terraces that overlook the pool and Zen gardens.

# 129 Spring Valley Rd, Ridgefield, CT

#### **Price:** \$4,695,000

**Splashy features:** When you have waterfalls, a stream, and a lake on your 31-acre property in Connecticut, all you really need is a a lap pool completely enclosed with glass to round out the water features. The pool runs parallel to the river, to offer the feeling of swimming outdoors year-round. There are

glorious views of the countryside from the glass poolhouse, the guest cottage, and the main residence, which was built from two vintage barns that were taken apart and reconstructed.

**Splashy features:** Perched on the highest point of a ridge above the Old Santa Fe Trail, this is a spectacular lap pool, with a view! Throw in an attached spa and a round, sunken conversation area with a fire pit, and you have a beautiful backyard. Plus it's all consummately private, because the 7,298-square-foot home sits at the summit of a 53-acre lot.

#### **Price:** \$3,139,000

**Splashy features:** This brand-new house, built on a small lot, features a spa and 84-foot lap pool that wraps around the house. It's strategically set along one side, so lawn space isn't sacrificed, and it makes meaningful use of the side yard, a usually forgotten strip of property. There's plenty of space for an outdoor living room with a fireplace and waterfall, a fully equipped barbecue area, and multiple patios and decks.

**Splashy features:** Just to show you don't have to be a millionaire to enjoy the virtues of a lap pool, this reasonably priced home has a heated, saltwater pool.
