

Open House Obsession: In Venice, An Extraordinary Homage To Albert Frey, \$3.2M

Where: 2022 Alberta Avenue, Venice

When: Sunday, September 23 from 2:00pm-5:00pm

Asking: \$3,195,000

What: An extraordinary 3-bed, 4-bath house by **Martin Zünkeler of bau 10 Architects**, the LA-based design and architecture practice—impeccably detailed, with a crisp facade and exquisitely crafted interior, inspired by the work of the Albert Frey [1903-1998] the Swiss-born, Palm Springs-based architect considered to be the father of Desert Modernism.

In some ways, Zünkeler has taken Frey to the next level, using technology and materials (and a budget) the great master could only dream of. Immediately inside, you grasp that the entire house

will be a tour-de-force of cabinet work, almost completely executed in a golden, sustainable teak.



Listed as a bedroom, this is more than likely going to become a perfect home office.




